## Notes

- To type the high-tone accent ´ use the **Grave key** ` after typing the vowel. **á** is typed **a** then **Grave**.
- To type the nasal accent ̣ use the **Left-Bracket key** [ after typing the vowel. **á** is typed **a** then **Left-Bracket**.
- To type the high-nasal accent ̇ use the **Right-Bracket key** ] after typing the vowel. **á** is typed **a** then **Right-Bracket**.
- The **ł (barred-l)**, **ə**, and **? (glottal stop)** letters have their own keys.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semicolon ;** is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
  - single: ‘ Grave — ’ Apostrophe
  - double: “ Shift+Left-Bracket — ” Shift+Right-Bracket
  - single ‹ Right-Alt+Shift+9 — › Right-Alt+Shift+0
  - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
