
## Miwəmeti (Sierra Miwok) Keyboard Layout

- 1. Where a punctuation key has been remapped, hold down the RIGHT-ALT (Windows) or OPTION (Mac) key and type the punctuation. For example, the semicolon; is produced by holding down the RIGHT-ALT key and typing the semicolon key; (Windows) or holding down the OPTION key and typing the semicolon key; (Mac).
- 2. The dotted letter can also be produced by typing a base letter followed by the RIGHT-ALT+BACKSLASH (Windows) or OPTION+BACKSLASH (Mac). This key allows for letters like *ş*.
- 3. Proper opening and closing quotation marks have special keys.
  - a. "Double quotes" are on the SHIFT+COMMA and SHIFT+PERIOD keys.
  - b. 'Single quotes' are on the GRAVE and APOSTROPHE keys.
  - c. «Double guillemets» are RIGHT-ALT+9 and RIGHT-ALT+0 (Windows) or OPTION+9 and OPTION+0 (Mac).
  - d. (Single guillemets) are SHIFT+RIGHT-ALT+9 and SHIFT+RIGHT-ALT+0 (Windows) or SHIFT+OPTION+9 and SHIFT+OPTION+0 (Mac).
