
Gwich'in Keyboard Layout



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Notes

- To type the low-tone accent `use the **Grave key** ` after typing the vowel. \hat{a} is typed a then **Grave** `.
- To type the nasal accent use the **Left-Bracket key** [after typing the vowel. **q** is typed **a** then **Left-Bracket et**.
- To type the low-nasal accent `use the **Right-Bracket key**] after typing the vowel. à is typed a then **Right-Bracket**.
- To type the falling-tone accent \hat{a} use the **Backslash key** \ after typing the vowel. \hat{a} is typed \hat{a} then **Backslash** \.
- To type the rising-tone accent "use the **Shift+Backslash key** after typing the vowel. **a** is typed **a** then **Shift+Backslash**.
- The *l* (barred-l) letter has its own key.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semi-colon**; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - □ single: 'Grave —' Apostrophe
 - □ double: "Shift+Left-Bracket "Shift+Right-Bracket
 - □ single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - □ double « Right-Alt+9 » Right-Alt+0
