Notes

- All accents are typed after the base character: *á* is typed **a** then **Slash /**.
- To type the nasal accent *ḁ* use the **Left-bracket key [**. *ḁ* is typed **e** then **Left-bracket [**.
- To type the high-tone accent *é* use the **Slash key /**. *é* is typed **e** then **Slash /**.
- To type the high-tone nasal accent *ḛ* use the **Shift+Slash key**. *ḛ* is typed **e** then **Shift+Slash**.
- To type the long accent *ē* use the **Hyphen key -**. *ē* is typed **e** then **Hyphen -**.
- To type the long nasal accent *ḙ* use the **Shift+Hyphen key**. *ḙ* is typed **e** then **Shift+Hyphen**.
- To type the high-tone long accent *ḗ* use the **Equals key =**. *ḗ* is typed **e** then **Equals =**.
- To type the high-tone long nasal accent *ḟ* use the **Shift+Equals key**. *ḟ* is typed **e** then **Shift+Equals**.
- To type the falling-tone accent *ê* use the **Right-bracket key]**. *ê* is typed **e** then **Right-bracket]**.
- To type the falling-tone nasal accent *ḝ* use the **Shift+Right-bracket key**. *ḝ* is typed **e** then **Shift+Right-bracket**.
- To type the rising-tone accent *ě* use the **Backslash key **. *ě* is typed **e** then **Backslash **.
- To type the rising-tone nasal accent *ḡ* use the **Shift+Backslash key**. *ḡ* is typed **e** then **Shift+Backslash**.
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Left Bracket [** is typed **Right-Alt+Left-Bracket** (Windows) **Option+Left Bracket** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Shift+Left-Bracket — ’ Apostrophe
 - double: “ Right-Alt+Shift+7 — ” Right-Alt+Shift+8
 - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
