

Notes

- All accents are typed after the base character: <u>t</u> is typed t then **Semicolon**;
- To type the underline accent _ use the **Semicolon key**; \underline{k} is typed **k** then **Semicolon**;. Always use this key to type the underline accent, **never** use your word processor's underline formatting function. Underlined letters can also by accessed by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**: \underline{q} would be **Right-Alt**/ **Option+q**.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semi-colon**; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - □ single: 'Grave —' Apostrophe
 - □ double: "Shift+Hyphen "Shift+Equal
 - □ single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - □ double « Right-Alt+9 » Right-Alt+0
