

Notes

- All accents are typed after the base character: **é** is typed **e** then **Grave** `.
- To type the acute accent 'use the **Grave key**'. \acute{a} is typed a then **Grave**'.
- To type the glottalized accent 'use the **Apostrophe key**'. k' is typed k then **Apostrophe**'.
- On the keymap above, where two characters are shown on one alphabetic key, the right-hand letter is accessed with the **Shift key**. $^{\text{w}}$ is **Shift+w**, and ε is **Shift+e**.
- Captial letters are typed using the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. Capital *A* is **Right-Alt+a**/ **Option+a**. Capital *E* is **Right-Alt+Shift+a**/ **Option+Shift+a**.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semi-colon**; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - □ single: 'Shift+Grave 'Shift+Comma
 - □ double: "Shift+Hyphen "Shift+Equal
 - □ single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - □ double « Right-Alt+9 » Right-Alt+0
