
Nłe²kepmxcín Keyboard Layout

Notes

- The special characters of Nłe?kepmxcín have been assigned to the number keys. To type the numerals, hold down the Right-Alt or Option key then press the appropriate number key. The Numeric keypad on the right side of many keyoards keep its original numbers.
- All accents are typed after the base character \vec{t} is typed t then Apostrophe '
- To type the glottalized accent 'use the Apostrophe key ' k is typed k then Apostrophe '
- To type the acute accent ' use the **Semicolon key** ; \dot{a} is typed **a** then **Semicolon** ;
- To type the grave accent `use the Grave key ` \dot{a} is typed a then Grave `
- To type the low-dot accent _ use the 1 key c is typed c then 1 X can also be typed with the 7 key.
- There is no need to type the apostophe accent after \dot{x} , it is included in the keystroke.
- The English keyboard's punctuation marks can be typed by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The *Left-Bracket* [is typed **Right-Alt+Left-Bracket** (Windows) **Option+Left-Bracket** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - ▷ single: ' Left-Bracket ' Right-Bracket
 - ▷ double: "Shift+Left-Bracket "Shift+Right-Bracket

 - ▷ double « Right-Alt+Hyphen » Right-Alt+Equals
