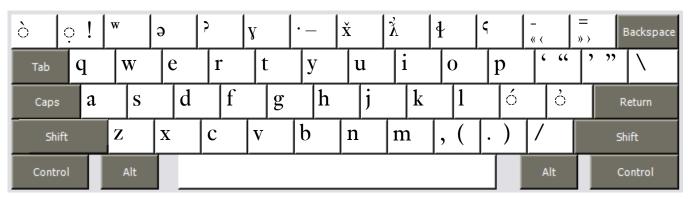
Sửáżimxec Keyboard



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Notes

- The special characters of Sλάλimxec have been assigned to the number keys. To type the numerals, hold down the Right-Alt or Option key then press the appropriate number key. The Numeric keypad on the right side of many keyoards keep its original numbers.
- All accents are typed after the base character \vec{t} is typed t then Apostrophe'
- To type the glottalized accent 'use the **Apostrophe key'** k is typed k then **Apostrophe'**
- To type the acute accent 'use the Semicolon key; \acute{a} is typed a then Semicolon;
- To type the grave accent `use the Grave key ` \dot{a} is typed a then Grave `
- To type the low-dot accent $\dot{}$ use the 1 key \dot{c} is typed \dot{c} then 1
- There is no need to type the apostophe accent after λ , it is included in the keystroke.
- The English keyboard's punctuation marks can be typed by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The *Left-Bracket* [is typed **Right-Alt+Left-Bracket** (Windows) **Option+Left-Bracket** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - ⊳ single: 'Left-Bracket 'Right-Bracket
 - ▷ double: "Shift+Left-Bracket "Shift+Right-Bracket
 - $\quad \quad \text{single} \leftarrow \text{Right-Alt+Shift+Hyphen} \longrightarrow \text{Right-Alt+Shift+Equals}$
 - b double « Right-Alt+Hyphen » Right-Alt+Equals
