


Nuučaaňuł (Number Keys) Keyboard



Notes

- The special characters of Nuučaaňuł have been assigned to the number keys. To type the numerals, hold down the Right-Alt or Option key then press the appropriate number key. The Numeric keypad on the right side of many keyboards keep its original numbers.
- All accents are typed after the base character: *ṫ* is typed *t* then **Apostrophe** '.
- To type the glottalized accent ' use the **Apostrophe key**'. *k̇* is typed *k* then **Apostrophe** '.
- Right-Alt+n** (Windows) **Option+n** (Mac) types *ŋ*.
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Left-Bracket** [is typed **Right-Alt+Left-Bracket** (Windows) **Option+Left-Bracket** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Left-Bracket — ’ Right-Bracket
 - double: “ Shift+Left-Bracket — ” Shift+Right-Bracket
 - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0

Notes

- All accents are typed after the base character: *t̄* is typed *t* then **Apostrophe** '.
- To type the glottalized accent ' use the **Apostrophe key**'. *k̄* is typed *k* then **Apostrophe** '.
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semicolon** ; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Shift+7 — ’ Shift+8
 - double: “ Shift+Comma — ” Shift+Period
 - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
