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Notes

- Accents are typed after the base character: *q* is typed *a* then **Slash /**
- To type the nasal (ogonek) accent *ȳ* use the **Slash key /** — *ĩ* is typed *i* then **/**
- To type the acute accent *’* use the **Left-Bracket key [** — *á* is typed *a* then **[**
- To type the nasal-acute accent *ȳ* use the **Shift+Left-Bracket key {** — *ĩ* is typed *i* then **{**
- To type the circumflex accent *^* use the **Right-Bracket key]** — *â* is typed *a* then **]**
- To type the nasal-circumflex accent *ȳ* use the **Shift+Right-Bracket key }** — *î* is typed *i* then **}**
- To type the short (breve) accent *˘* use the **Grave (Backquote) key `** — *ĩ* is typed *i* then **`**
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Slash /** is typed **Right-Alt+Slash** (Windows) **Option+Slash** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Shift+Grave (Backquote) — ’ Apostrophe
 - double: “ Shift+Hyphen — ” Shift+Equals
 - single ‹ Right-Alt+Shift+9 — › Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
