Notes

- Accents are typed after the base letter.
- The under-dot accent is on the Slash key / P is typed P then /
- The raised ${}^{n}N$ and ${}^{c}C$ have their own separate keys.
- The *prime* '(used for stress) and the *apostrophe* '(for glottal stops) each have separate keys.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Slash** / is typed **Right-Alt+Slash** (Windows) **Option+Slash** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - □ single: 'Backquote 'Apostrophe
 - □ double: "Right-Alt+Comma "Right-Alt+Period
 - □ single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 → Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - □ double « Right-Alt+9 » Right-Alt+0
