## Notes

- To type *đ* use the **Left-bracket key** [.
- To type *đ* use the **Right-bracket key** ].
- To type *ş* use the **Equals key** =.
- To type *ñ* use the **Slash key** /.
- To type the breve accent *˘* use the **Grave key** ` . *ă* is typed **a** then **Grave**.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The *Semicolon ;* is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
  - single: ‘ Shift+Grave — ’ Apostrophe
  - double: “ Shift+Comma — ” Shift+Period
  - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
  - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
