Notes

- To type the acute accent ´ use the **Right-Bracket key]** after typing the vowel. *á* is typed **a** then **Right-Bracket**.
- To type the ligatured d, *ḍḍ*, use the **Slash key /** between the two d’s. *ḍḍ* is typed **d** then **Slash** then **d**.
- The *ñ (n-tilde)*, *ɓ*, *ḍ* and the optional *º* letters have their own keys.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The *Semicolon ;* is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Shift+6 — ’ Apostrophe
 - double: “ Shift+Hyphen — ” Shift+Equals
 - single ‹ Right-Alt+Shift+9 — › Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double ‹‹ Right-Alt+9 — ›› Right-Alt+0
