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## Notes

- Some of the syllabics finals may be ambiguous on the map above:
  - ightharpoonup The w-dot is on the **backquote key**, as in  $\underline{\triangleleft}$  not to be confused with the period .
  - ▶ The p-final is on the **shift-W key**, as in  $\underline{\triangleleft}$  the ejective diacritic is on the **slash key**, as in  $\underline{\subseteq}$
  - The k-final is on the **shift-R key**, as in  $\underline{\triangleleft}$  the nasal diacritic is on the **z key**, as in  $\underline{\triangleleft}$
  - The m-final is on the **shift-Y key**, as in  $\underline{\triangleleft}^{c}$  the aspirate diacritic is on the **x key**, as in  $\underline{\triangleleft}^{c}$
  - The y-final is on the **shift-P key**, as in  $\underline{\triangleleft}$  not to be confused with the plus-sign  $\underline{+}$
  - For convenience, the t-final is on the **m key** as well as on the **shift-E key**, as in  $\underline{\triangleleft}'$
- On Macs, when the **CAPS-LOCK** is turned on, the keyboard reverts to a US English layout.
- By holding down the **Right-Alt key (Windows)** or **Option key (Mac)**, it is possible to access the numbers and punctuation marks as mapped on a US English keyboard.
